

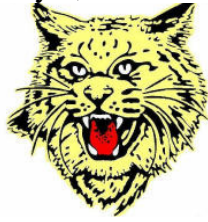

### **AGENDA**

- I. **Roll Call**- at 7 PM, present were all Northwestern Board Committee members and Greenfield Board Committee members Greg Griswold and Larry Pembroke. In addition present for Greenfield were Supt. Bill Bishop, Athletic Director Dan Bowman and Assistant AD Joey Pembroke. For Northwestern, Athletic Director Nick Troutwine, Principal Brenda Mitchell and Supt. Gayle Early were present. Guests present were Howard Phillips, Leslie Barrow and Kyle McNeely.
- II. **Old business** – Basketball and Baseball – the possibility of co-oping baseball for this year was discussed and it was decided that in order to assure that we have a baseball time for this year we would need to ask to have both boards approve and then notify IHSA. For basketball, it was discussed that any future coop was at least 2 years away and that Northwestern would have to be accepted into the WIVC Conference before it would be considered as a host school.
- III. **New Business** –Bryan Thomson told committee members that a community petition was going to be sent around by a Northwestern citizen to see how many people were in support of a basketball coop with Greenfield.
- IV. **Other** - It was decided that both committees would recommend to their respective boards at the Sept. meeting that a baseball coop be approved at for this year so that students would be assured of having a team.
