A motion was made by Lisa Meisenheimer and seconded by Brock Campbell to Post for Junior High Assistant Volleyball Coach. Those voting yes were Lancaster, Campbell, Eades, Murphy, Meisenheimer, Cox and Camerer. Motion carried.

A motion was made by John Murphy and seconded by Tasha Lancaster to Approve Overnight Trip for FFA BUILD Conference at Illinois State University on November 25-26, 2024. Those voting yes were Meisenheimer, Murphy, Cox, Lancaster, Campbell, Camerer and Eades. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Becky Camerer and seconded by Linda Eades to Approve Resolution providing for the issue of not to exceed \$768,600 General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2024, for the purpose of altering and reconstructing school buildings and purchasing and installing equipment therein for fire prevention and safety, energy conservation and school security purposes, providing for the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest on said bonds, and authorizing the sale of said bonds to the purchaser thereof and treasurer surety bond.
