4. Complete and submit the scholarship application and attachments on or before the deadline.

3. One Essay
4. The deadline to submit is April 28, 2026
5. Selected students must submit to Mrs. Hampton the school they will be attending, as well as an address and student ID number for the check to be sent directly to the school.
